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<u>Abstract</u>: - Why is this important? Because once we are open to this idea, we can work towards the conscious creation of a new energy field - let's call it the field of stable development. I believe this field can be so powerful that will be able to stop even military conflicts from happening.

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Dear reader, in this article I present a new idea, where I describe the sovereign state as a distinct living organism, and the people within its geographical boundaries as its living cells. I hope your curious mind enjoys this new hypothesis!

So let's start with the question that I raised in my article "Where are we?" The question is: What if the "almighty" human being is only a small cell of a larger energy structure, and that structure is superior to any of its individual cells? So, instead of assuming we are "the big", let's assume we are "the small".

Now, let's see, based on that assumption, what kind of a picture of the world we get:

First, we will have to dethrone man as the intellectual king of all creatures, and accept the idea that each of us is a living cell of a larger living organism, and this organism has intellect which is superior to ours.

Then we have to expand the notion of a "living organism".

For example, a beehive, according to my hypothesis, is a living organism, and each individual bee is simply a living cell in that organism. The wooden structure of the hive can be viewed as the material boundary of that organism.

Similarly, in the human society, the sovereign state (country) is the living organism that consists of the people inhabiting its legal geographical territory.

This way, the sovereign country becomes an energy superstructure, comprised of the emotional, intellectual, sexual and etc. known and unknown energies of its cells (a.k.a. its citizens or inhabitants). I think there are probably also energy fields that are not created by a man. But for that later on. As such, the sovereign state, as a living organism, defines, to a very large degree, the destiny of its citizens. Of course, just like with any other living organism, in the state organism, each of its individual cells (a.k.a each individual inhabitant), also influences the destiny of its country, but to an inconsiderably smaller degree.

Dear reader, you can probably already see that, in my theory, the sovereign state is not simply a geographical area on the map, but it is a living organism, with its own intellect. It is a stable superstructure that functions at a higher intellectual level than any of its citizens, and so individuals cannot manage it. This structure is governed by the interactions of the conscious energy fields in it.

So let's go deeper into the details of my hypothesis.

First, what is a sovereign state?

A sovereign state is a politically organized community that occupies a defined territory, uses a common language, has a government (system of governance), and is granted internal and external sovereignty. The state is a fundamental institute of the political system of our society. Through a system of state bodies, the state manages the society and its social relations. The main functions of the state are internal (within its territory and in relation to its citizens) and external (outside of its territory in managing its interstate relations). The true power of the state is the enforcement of justice.

The above is the common definition of a sovereign state.

In my new hypothesis, however, unlike the common definition, I suggest that each state is born from and governed by a number of conscious energy fields. These fields are both human (generated by the people that inhabit the state) and non-human (generated by other energy sources). So which are these fields specifically? First, it is the energy field of the physical land where the state has its geographical territory. This energy field is not human (a.k.a. it is not created by the fields of the people that inhabit the territory of a country) but it is created by the planet Earth itself. In my theory, this field is the main reason for all the wars that had led to redistribution of territories in the past. There is nothing human in these wars. We cannot explain why war conflicts, that had caused so much death and destruction in the past, have never been possible to avoid. And, I think, the explanation is very simple: it is the impact of the energy field of the land! It seems that the main driving force of this field is to expand the territory of its respective country. This force is extremely powerful and cannot be overturned by the human intellect. This has resulted in military conflicts that had shaped and continue to shape almost the entire history of mankind.

The second field is the energy field of the common language. This is a human generated field that unites the people of each country. While there have been some attempts in the past to introduce a common language for the entire planet (Esperanto), those have not been successful. I think we are not ready for that.

Third, it is the energy field of the political society. To describe the role of this field, I refer to the book "Man and the State" by Jean Maritain. In his book, Maritain describes the political society as having flesh and blood, instincts, passions, images, subconscious structures and energies all subordinated (and, if necessary, by the force of law) to the principles of ideas and rational decisions. Further, Maritain notes that justice is the precondition for the existence of a political society, but consent is its life-giving form. Maritain describes the State as subordinated to the political society as a whole and in service to the political society as a whole. In the context of this article, and in my interpretation of Maritain's ideas, I view the energy field of the political society as playing a significant role in ensuring the stable existence of the State.

The last example of an energy field, that creates and defines the sovereign state as a living organism, is the energy field of the human emotions. The influence of this field on the functioning of the state is the easiest for us to understand and observe. It is manifested in the love, hate, nostalgia, and etc. emotions that penetrate and shape our conversations, fears and hopes, our life. This field is extremely malleable in its reactions to the influences of all other fields.

Dear reader, in addition to the four fields mentioned above, the state as an energy superstructure likely is governed by many other known and unknown to us energy sources. But my goal in this article was not talk about all of them. My goal was rather to introduce the idea that the sovereign state is a standalone energy superstructure, governed by the combined energy fields of its constituents. Why is this important? Because once we are open to this idea, we can work towards the conscious creation of a new energy field - let's call it the field of stable development. I believe this field can be so powerful that will be able to stop even military conflicts from happening.
